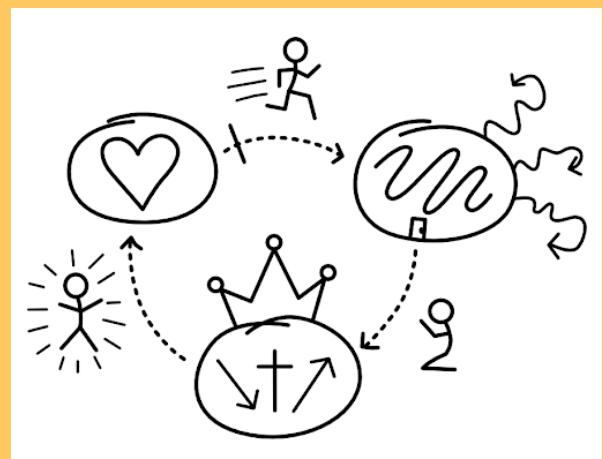
**WE WANT SOMETHING FOR YOU
